

COLUMBUS[★] PORCH PROTECTION PROGRAM

Reducing Crime & Improving Neighborhood Safety

The City of Columbus' **Porch Protection Program** is a pilot project sponsored by Columbus City Attorney Zach Klein to distribute camera-equipped doorbells to Columbus households to reduce crime, combat package theft, and improve neighborhood safety.

Eligible households who register will be entered into a lottery to receive a free Ring doorbell. Applications must be received by **Monday, December 9, 2024**, with pickup events the following week. Entering the lottery does not guarantee a camera. Households chosen to receive a camera will be contacted by the City Attorney's Office.

Enter Lottery to Receive a Free Ring Doorbell Camera

Eligible applicants must:

- Own their home or receive approval from their landlord to install a camera-equipped doorbell
- Earn up to 200% of the federal poverty level per household
- Live in a qualifying ZIP code: **43201, 43204, 43207, 43211, 43219, 43223, 43224, 43228, 43229, or 43232**
